I. CALL TO ORDER

Chair Stohs called the meeting to order at 12:00 PM. Chair Stohs introduced Senator Stambough as the newly elected chair for AY 2020-21 Academic Senate Executive Committee.

III. ANNOUNCEMENTS

- (Dabirian) There are a lot of forms and processes that are still trying to become technology-based. IT has worked with Adobe Sign, which is similar to DocuSign, to allow our campus to use electronic signatures on documents. IT will be working with departments to make it easy for them to utilize the electronic method of processing forms and we are working to be ready with the process for fall. IT is trying to make the process as simple as possible.
- ➤ IT is doing everything they can to enhance the fall semester, from what was done this spring, regarding moving everyone to virtual. We are introducing SoftPhone, which will allow faculty and staff to receive and make phone calls and have the same headset as their office. This way when you publish your phone number in your syllabus, or any place your number is already published, students, faculty, and staff can call you. Many people are forwarding their office phone to their cell phone or making calls from their cell phone, but they don't want to give out their number. When making a call, a softphone will display the office number and not their number. A message will go out to the entire campus with instructions on how to request a SoftPhone.
- Another product IT is looking to roll out for the campus is proctor monitoring. We are looking at Proctorio, which is a product the Nursing Department uses. We look to have that ready for the fall semester.
- We are looking at enhancing things like writing devices, so when you use Zoom and other features, it will benefit faculty and staff.
- We are rolling out our virtual infrastructure more so that you will have access to high-end labs.
- > IT will be communicating everything to the campus within the next week or so.
- It was brought to our attention that some people would like to have extra monitors, they need them to be able to do their job better. IT is looking at all of the devices to see how we can expand some of those to the faculty, the same way we did for the laptops and other devices we provided.
- (Graewingholt) On behalf of the library, we are trying to get the materials that you might need for your courses, so I would like to encourage all of you to reach out to your librarians or subject liaisons. You can reach out to me if you don't know who your subject librarian is. We are doing a lot to try and make curriculum materials available electronically for faculty trying to recreate their courses. If you need help with your textbook or with low-cost alternatives, we can refer you to get that accomplished. With moving to Canvas, Dean Bonney is looking at Leganto potentially to allow for e-reserves to be more robust and for our digitization to ramp up in that arena. If you need assistance, I encourage you to reach out; we are here for you.
 - Q: (Kanel) My faculty are asking about summer school textbooks. Are those textbooks that are ordered, are they going to be in the Titan Shops and are students going on campus to purchase them? Does anybody know anything about that process?

A: (Graewingholt) I know the list that had been submitted to Titan Shops, our Collection Development Librarian is currently looking at any and all electronic options for students so they don't have to physically. We are in the process of purchasing access to a software program called Leganto, which will be helpful as faculty begin to build their new courses in Canvas. Leganto will help them integrate material and course reserves directly into their online courses. They are also looking at something like an Amazon locker type situation, or some sort of curbside service for print reserves. More info on this to come from the Dean.
