 - (Meyer) Change the word "released" to "reassigned" throughout the document. Considered friendly.

 - 1. Revisions to UPS 300.004 Policy on Syllabi (Course Outlines) clean version (EC edits 12-6-22)
 - M/S/P (Kleinjans/Barber) Motion to approve ASD 22-114 Revisions to UPS 300.004 Policy on Syllabi (Course Outlines).
 - (Jarvis) Line 47: strike out line "D" and reword item "E" to read: the grading scale which includes a clear indication of +/- grading will be used". Considered friendly.
 - (Bauer) Line 87: It should be Title IX.

- M/S/P (Dabirian/Mallicoat) Lines 10-12: strike out the wording "normally and preferably" and spell out "Learning Management System". The sentence will read "No later than the end of the first full week of classes, the students shall be provided with an ADA accessible syllabus in form of a digital document, and the syllabus shall be posted on the Learning Management System". Motion approved.
 - (Kleinjans) Remove the wording "and the syllabus" and replace it with "which". Considered friendly.
 - (Mallicoat) add the word "University". Considered friendly.
 - (Barber) add the word "the". Considered friendly.

- M/S/P (Kleinjans/Lewis Chiu) Preferably by the first day of classes and no later than the end of the first full week of classes, the students shall be provided with an ADA accessible syllabus in the form of a digital document, which shall be posted on the University Learning Management System. Motion approved.
 - (Kanel) restructure to the sentence to read: Students shall be provided with an ADA accessible syllabus in the form of a digital document, which shall be posted on the University Learning Management System.

The instructor shall provide this document preferably by the first day of class and shall post it no later than the end of the first full week of classes in fall and spring semesters. In winter and summer session instructor shall provide this document by the first day of class.

- (Wood) Line 14: change the "shall" to "should". Considered friendly.
- (Bruce) Line 14: add the wording "and shall post it...". Considered friendly.
