Resolution on Irvine Campus Task Force Report

- 1. **RESOLVED** that the Academic Senate thank the members of the Irvine Campus Task Force for the Final Report dated January 8, 2010; and be it further
- 2. **RESOLVED** that the Academic Senate endorse the Task Force vision of several partners working together, including city, public agencies, private entities, and the Chancellor's Office and Board of Trustees, to create a branch campus in south county serving, hopefully, 3,000 to 6,000 FTES; and be it further
- 3. **RESOLVED** that until such time as the aforementioned partnership is realized, a reasonable cap on enrollments and expenditures for the Irvine campus be established; and be it further
- 4. **RESOLVED** that the Academic Senate encourage the President to seek from the Chancellor financial resources to help support the continuation of the Irvine branch campus; and be it further
- 5. **RESOLVED** that the Academic Senate endorse the Task Force recommendation that full-time tenure-track faculty shall not be mandated to teach at the south county branch campus; and be it further
- 6. **RESOLVED** that the Academic Senate recommend that the practice of restricting students to enrolling at the Irvine campus exclusively for any period of time be removed; and be it further
- 7. **RESOLVED** that the Academic Senate urge that the current practice of staffing classes on the Irvine campus shall continue to be controlled by the appropriate academic department on the main campus, and be it further
- 8. **RESOLVED** that the Academic Senate support the Task Force recommendation that a standing committee on the Irvine/south county branch campus be formed. This shall be a standing committee of the Academic Senate with its membership and functions to be delineated in UPS 100.000 and UPS 100.001.
