Support of Proposition 30 on the November 2012 Ballot: Temporary Taxes to Fund Education. Guaranteed Local Public Safety Funding

The Academic Senate of CSU Fullerton joins the Academic Senate of the CSU and others in the higher education community in endorsing Prop 30 on the November ballot. Should Prop 30 fail, the CSU will experience a "trigger cut" of \$250 million, further limiting student access to quality and affordable public higher education in the short run and California's economic development in the future.
