



Academic Senate approved unanimously 8-30-18

Faculty Representation on the Presidential Selection Committee

- a. Chair of the Academic Senate (as mandated by Board of Trustee policy)
- b. Two (2) faculty elected by the campus faculty (also mandated by Board of Trustee policy)

Recommendation: The Academic Senate Executive Committee recommends the following procedure:

Within the week of a presidential vacancy being announced, the Chair of the Academic Senate will meet with the Elections Committee and then inform the campus of an all-faculty election in which full and part time faculty are eligible to vote. Tenured/tenure track faculty interested in serving on this Presidential Selection Committee will be required to submit a petition of ten (10) valid tenured/tenure track faculty signatures and they are also invited to submit a statement of no more than 100 words. All faculty will then receive a ballot electronically as soon as possible. Temporary faculty votes will be prorated in terms of the number of weighted teaching units taught during the current semester, e.g., one course = .2 of a full vote. The two elected faculty will be the highest vote getters from two (2) different Colleges. Ties shall be decided by lot among those tied. The names of those elected, as well as the name of the Academic Senate Chair, will then be forwarded to the Chairman of the CSU Board of Trustees and to the Chancellor. Vote tallies are to be posted as we do with all other elections conducted by the Academic Senate.
