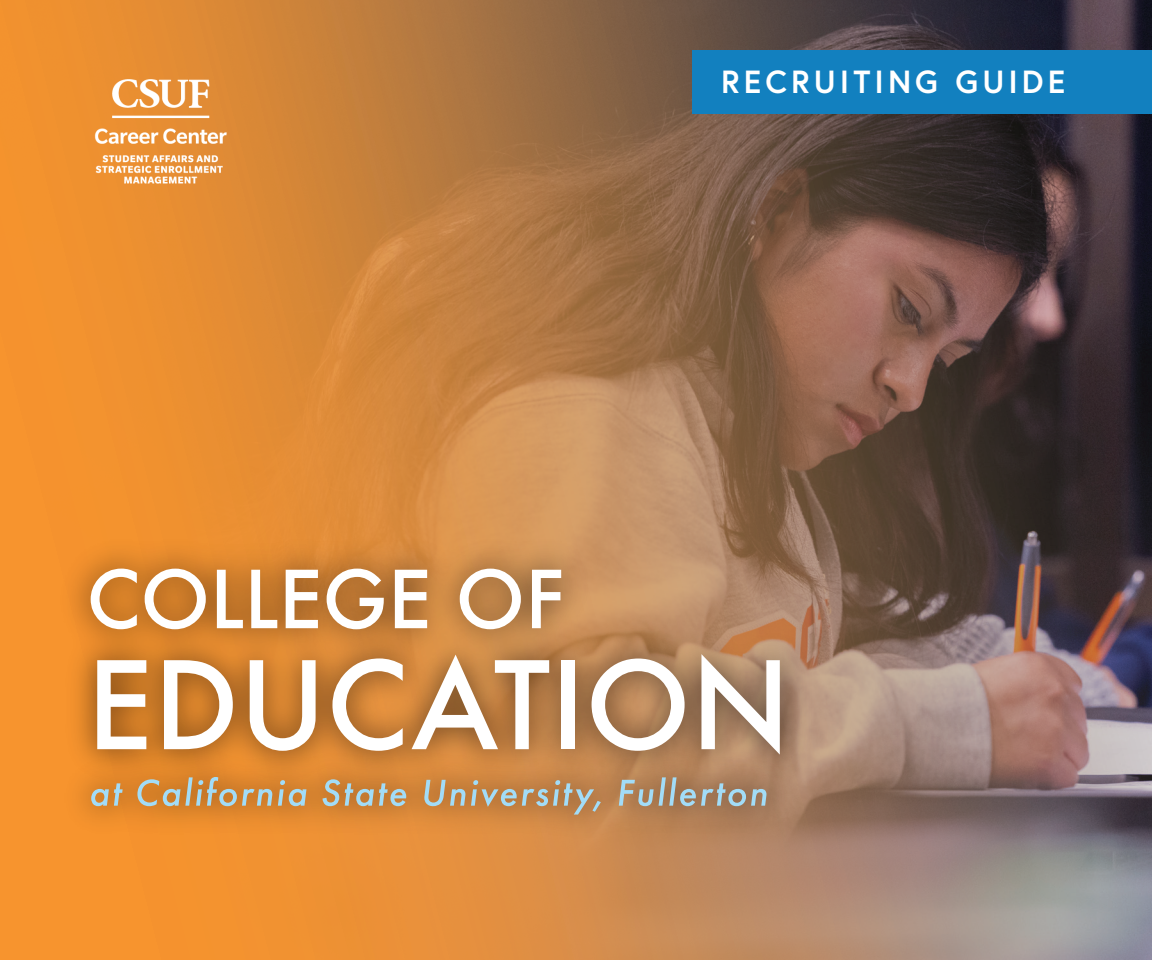

How to recruit College of Education majors

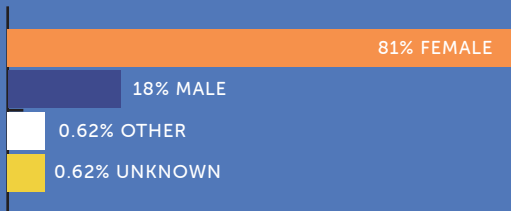
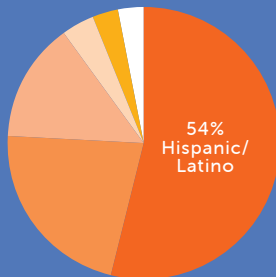
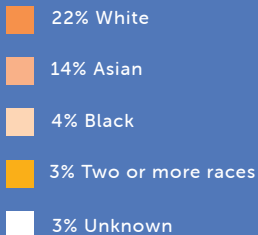
- Post jobs, internships, and credential-appropriate roles on Titan Connection through the CSUF Career Center to reach CSUF talent directly.

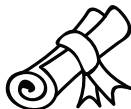
