Transfer Students

Transfer students interested in transferring directly into upper-division (junior level) B.F.A. Acting program must first initiate a transfer equivalence evaluation with the department Undergraduate Advisement Coordinator. To qualify for a B.F.A. degree with a major in theatre, students must earn a "C" (2.0) or better in all theatre, dance or music courses required for the degree.

To remain in the program, students must maintain a 3.0 G.P.A. in all performance area courses. They will be evaluated each semester on their cumulative work in class and in production by members of the performance faculty. The faculty will collectively recommend an annual, individual learning plan for each student to promote growth and success.
