The Spotlight Shorts Theatre Festival is located on the CSUF campus, primarily in the Clayes Performing Arts Center (CPAC on map).

# Frequently Asked Questions

01

**How can I register for this event?** Register using the QR code above to schedule your students to perform at the Spotlight Shorts Theatre Festival.

**What time will the Spotlight Short Theatre Festival end?** Students will be released after the Awards Ceremony & Showcase at 3 p.m.

**What can I bring for my performance?** Each performance space will supply 2 classroom tables, 3 chairs, and a bluetooth speaker. Each performance group may bring hand props and soft goods to supplement their 10-Minute Performance.

**What kind of performances are admissible?** We encourage ALL genres of performances, as long as each group has a minimum of 2 performers.

**Will lunch be provided?** Lunch will NOT be provided for participants but there are a variety of dining options available on campus for purchase in the TSU. All food must be eaten in designated outdoor areas near the CPAC building or in the TSU.
