Provisions of Early Resolution Agreements included No Contact Orders, disciplinary probation, suspension, training, meeting with Title IX Coordinator to review applicable policies and definitions, restrictions on access to campus facilities, removal from a student organization, restrictions on access to campus services, eviction from housing, and relocation within housing community.

Other outcomes include academic supportive measures (such as change of class schedules, switching to independent study, extensions on assignments, retaking exams, alternative assignments, etc.), housing relocation, referrals for campus resources (counseling, Campus Confidential Advocate, Tuffy's Basic Needs, Care Services, CSUFPD Safety Escort Program, etc.), or referral to community resources (restraining orders, criminal reporting, emergency shelters, counseling, etc.). 102 of these 150 cases involve Respondents that are either unidentified and/or not affiliated with Cal State Fullerton.
