(Note: CFRs reflect the revised 2023 Standards, which no longer include diversity, equity and inclusion.)</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Provide an update on the university’s efforts to determine the differential impact of various student success initiatives. (CFRs 2.3, 2.7, 2.10, 4.1, and 4.6)</li> <li>2. Continue to focus on program assessment to ensure full participation in the six-step process and the use of results to improve teaching and learning, with particular attention to those programs that have lagged behind in meeting this requirement. (CFRs 2.7, 4.5, and 4.6)</li> <li>3. Expand the number of graduate programs with Program Learning Outcomes aligned to Graduate Learning Goal 6 and develop graduate-specific student success initiatives. (CFRs 2.3, 2.7, 2.9, and 2.10)</li> <li>4. Develop more systematic means for engaging staff in key university committees and initiatives. (CFRs 3.1 and 3.9)</li> <li>5. Continue to focus on the most effective methods of delivering appropriate mental health services for students and alternative delivery models. (CFR 2.13)</li> <li>6. Carefully monitor data security, compliance, and student privacy rights as the institution deploys digital and online tools. (CFRs 1.3 and 3.6)</li> </ol>
