We are encouraging students to register to vote or to update their voter registration at the following link: <https://registertovote.ca.gov/?t=s>

***Reminder to select CSUF during step 3

To [register to vote](#) in California, you must be:

- A United States citizen and a resident of California
- 18 years old or older on Election Day (Nov. 5, 2024)
- Not currently in a state or federal prison or on parole for the conviction of a felony
- Not currently found mentally incompetent to vote by a court

All registered voters will receive a Vote-By-Mail ballot to the address associated with their voter registration. If voters have moved, they should update their address by re-registering to vote to ensure receipt of their election materials and ballot.

Voting Options

Vote by Mail

- *Registered* voters receive a Vote-By-Mail ballot sent to the address listed on their voter registration.
- If you have moved, you may need to *re-register* with your new address to prevent your ballot from being delivered to your previous address.
- You can verify your voter registration online with the Secretary of State's "[My Voter Status](#)" tool.

Early & In-Person Voting

- Whether you vote in-person or by mail, consider voting early to avoid long lines on Election Day or potential mail delays.
- Vote by using nearby voting options. To find vote centers and ballot drop boxes and their operating hours in Orange County, use this [link](#).
- The Titan Student Union will be a Vote Center between Nov. 1 to Nov 5 and there is an on-campus ballot drop box in Parking Lot G.
