

Preparing for your visit to the Desert Studies Center

Weather and road conditions can change rapidly in the Mojave Desert. Be prepared before you leave!

- Expect no cell service away from DSC; bring offline or print maps
- Tell trustworthy people where you are going and when you expect to return
- Carry ample water and food, appropriate clothing and safety gear, and essential tools (the nearest drug and full-service grocery stores are in Barstow, 55 mi S)
- Keep a full gas tank. Closest gas is in Baker (12 mi N) and at Rasor Rd exit (11 mi S).
- If driving in the Preserve, be sure that your vehicle has an inflated spare tire and that someone in your party knows how to change a tire
- Check current weather and road conditions, as well as I-15 traffic:

Checklist - What to bring:

non-disposable water bottle (at least 1 L)

brimmed hat

sunscreen (≥30 spf) boots or sturdy shoes

lightweight long-sleeve shirt

(sun protection - avoid wearing black,

which absorbs heat)

warm layers, hat, and gloves

(for winter - cold and windy)

toiletries and medications

personal first aid kit

bath towel

sleeping bag and pillow

mobile phone and wall charger

Optional:

sunglasses binoculars

camera

field notebook and pencil

non-disposable coffee/tea mug
