CalGeo: CalGeo x ITE Bowling Social(requesting \$232.78) APPROVED

- Who are CalGeo and ITE
- Bowling social at TSU; already reserved
- Free & open to all
- Expected attendance: 45 people
- CalGeo and ITE will be splitting total costs
- Hospitality, requesting \$116.39/club = total \$232.78
- Unanimous approval - 23 votes

(CalGeo motions, SHPE seconds)

OSS: Collegiate Penetration Testing Competition(requesting \$320) APPROVED

- OSS - Cybersecurity club, offensive/defensive hacking
- CPTC - collegiate cybersecurity competition - Nov 1st & 2nd
- Benefits: networking & Bring back knowledge to lead workshops
- Requesting travel - hotel \$320 for 8 people
- Simple majority required - 24 responses, 23 yes, 1 abstain

(OSS motions, ION seconds)

CalGeo: GeoCongress 2026 (requesting \$3000) APPROVED

- Geotechnical conference w/ GeoWall Competition
- Benefits: networking, fosters career growth, bring back innovations/insights to CSUF, participation in national competition
- 4 students attending & competing
- Hotel: \$128/night for 3 nights = \$384
- Registration fee: \$370/person = \$1480
- Flights: \$289/round trip + \$35 shipping = \$1191
- Requesting \$3000 total
- Discussed alternative flights and hotels
- Unanimous approval - 23 votes

(Rover motions, OSS seconds)

Sachin Lodhi: NeurIPS 2025 (requesting \$500) APPROVED

- Conference on AI and Machine Learning, selective acceptance
- Benefits: talks, workshops, establish partnerships w/ leading AI researchers, create opportunities for CSUF students, access to mentorship & research collaboration
- Requesting travel - registration fee \$475 + travel \$25 = \$500
- Requires simple majority - 23 responses, 22 yes, 1 no

(EDC motions, CalGeo seconds)

ACM: ICPC (Requesting \$700) APPROVED

- What is ACM
- International Collegiate Programming Contest - Riverside City College
- Benefits: oldest & largest programming competition, bring back knowledge/insight/experience for workshops, multiple teams = more chances to place + opportunities for algorithm team
- Requesting travel = registration \$175/team * 4 teams (10 people) = \$700
- Requires simple majority - 22 responses, unanimous approval

Association for Operations & Supply Chain Management(AOSCM) requests to join

- Why Supply Chain & ECS: related and reliant on e/o
- Benefits for students: access pathways into industries beyond technical design & operational systems, company tours, career fairs, internships, guest speakers
- Purpose: help students get internships, career development, promote networking, supply chain community
- Why ECS ICC - strengthen council's value, adjacent student community, leverage club infrastructure, cross-promotion & access
- Timeline: Approval -> Rep appointment -> coordinate leadership meeting -> integrate marketing -> prepare AOSCM for next year
- Q&A: 60 students in club, will consider receiving funding from ICC but mainly focus on networking, club collaboration - case studies, engineering company, joint tours, caps will not be adjusted
- Notes: does outside fundraising, executive board comprises of different majors
- Requires super majority: 23 votes, 17 yes, 7 no - may include invalid votes - unfinished business
