AOSCM Request to join (requires super majority; rejected 61.9% yes, 38.1% no; revote: 63.6% yes, 31.8% no, 4.5% abstain)

- Relevance to ECS: analytical skills, cross-collaboration, connections w/ ECS companies/roles (e.g. Rocket Lab, Amazon, Northrup Grumman)
- Has not been able to travel w/ BICC
- Request funding from traveling
- Registration fees max \$500/person
- Questions:
 - Collaborations w/ ECS clubs: Open to any opportunity to collaborate w/ ECS
- Reasons for rejection:
 - Club is mainly business-relevant; want ECS ICC to mainly support ECS clubs
 - Want to join to learn more about ECS
 - Will not be pulling much funding due to own funding team
 - Career fairs are not engineering/CS-centered
 - Collaboration is still possible w/o having to join ICC
 - Does not see benefit of supply chain in future career, therefore no benefit for AOSCM to join
 - Suppose ECS ICC does a career fair w/ each club bringing a company, AOSCM will not bring a relevant company, ECS students will not be interested
 - AOSCM members interested in ECS
