Instructions for Study Plan

Students must submit their study plan within the first 13 units of graduate coursework.

General Instructions

- **Step 1)** <u>Students need to download a blank study plan form</u> as an editable PDF file from the department website (cee.fullerton.edu).
- **Step 2)** To fill out your study plan, *you must decide your focus area.* There are four focus areas offered in the MS degree in Civil Engineering which are Construction Engineering & Management; Geotechnical Engineering; Structural Engineering; Water Resources Engineering.
- **Step 3)** To get MSCE degree, <u>students should complete total 30-unit of graduation work</u> (Ten 3-unit courses / Eight 3-unit courses + 6-unit Thesis).

Instructions for Study Plan Form

- 1. Fill out your name, student ID No. (CWID), date, address, home phone & work/cell phone No.
- 2. The portion of pre-classification requirements needs to be completed by the CEE department based on the information from the ECS Graduate and International Admissions Office.
- 3. The writing requirement section needs to be filled out based on the following guidelines. Students are expected to meet the writing requirements within the first 9 units of graduate coursework through one of the following ways:
 - a. EWP (Examination in Writing Proficiency)
 - b. ENGL 301 or 360 class (can't be included in a study plan)
 - c. EGCE 470, 534, 567, 573, 597 or 598 (can be included in a study plan)
 - d. A minimum score of 4 on the GRE Writing Assessment Test
- 4. For the Civil Engineering Courses, five core courses must be included in the study plan of each student according to his/her focus area. You can find the list of core courses for each focus area from the department website (cee.fullerton.edu).
- 5. For the Other Courses, students can put five elective courses which can be in their focus area or other focus areas.
- 6. Students take the Thesis option; they need to put total 6-unit for two semesters.
- 7. Students need to submit their study plan draft to the Graduate Advisor and finalize their study plan according to the comments from the Graduate Advisor.
