SSL VPN Setup for Macintosh

SSL VPN allows you to connect from off campus to access campus resources such as Entourage email client and file sharing. These instructions will guide you through the following:

- Logging into the VPN Server through the web
- Accessing Outlook Web Access
- Accessing your campus hard drive
- Logging out of Network Connect and VPN

Logging into the VPN Server through the Web

- 1. Open your web browser (Safari only!)
- 2. Type https://csufvpns.fullerton.edu in the address window and enter



3. Enter your University "username" and "password" and click on "sign in"



4. You may get a message asking if you trust the certificate. If so, click the "Trust" button.
