***Served 2,500+ families**




MISSION: Together with our stakeholders, we aim to alleviate education and health disparities, revitalize neighborhoods, and reduce the cycle of poverty.

- Increase access for bilingual/bicultural education, healthcare, health promotion, and medical prevention services






Goal 2
