



### **CSUF Resolution on Course Retirements**

- Whereas: The University Policy Statement 411.100 prescribes that any course that has not been offered in four years shall be retired from the university curriculum and the university catalog by the Office of Academic Programs; and
- Whereas: The global pandemic of the novel coronavirus has forced academic units to schedule the majority of classes virtually for AY 20/21; and
- Whereas: The nature of some courses makes virtual offering difficult; and
- Whereas: Because some courses are not easy to translate to a virtual format and departments may not want to offer these courses again until they can be offered as an in-person course; therefore, be it
- Resolved: That the course retirement policy outlined in UPS 411.100, Section IX D is suspended during the duration of the COVID-19 crises and mandated virtual instruction; and be it further
- Resolved: That the Office of Academic Programs is released from the duty to retire courses for AY 20/21; and be it further
- Resolved: That academic departments will work with the Office of Academic Programs to identify courses in the catalog that they do not plan to offer and to initiate retirement through the on-line curricular system; and be it further
- Resolved: That copies of this resolution be distributed to President Virjee, Provost Thomas, AVP Filowitz, the CSUF Academic Deans, and CSUF Department Chairs.
