Resolution to Amend the CSUF Academic Senate Constitution and Bylaws to Include Part-Time Faculty in the Electorate

Whereas: Part-time faculty (also known as lecturers or adjuncts) constitute a significant portion

of the instructional workforce at California State University, Fullerton (CSUF), and play a vital role in the university's academic mission, student success, and day-to-day

educational operations; and

Whereas: The current Academic Senate Constitution and Bylaws may exclude or insufficiently

recognize part-time faculty as voting members of the electorate, thereby limiting their

participation in shared governance; and

Whereas: Inclusive representation is essential to a democratic, equitable, and transparent

university governance structure; and

Whereas: Recognizing part-time faculty as full members of the electorate will enhance shared

governance, improve communication across campus constituencies, and reflect the university's stated commitments to diversity, equity, inclusion, and justice; therefore,

be it

Resolved: That the Academic Senate of California State University, Fullerton initiate the process

to amend the Constitution and Bylaws to include eligible part-time faculty as members

of the faculty electorate; and be it further

Resolved: That "faculty electorate" be defined to include all Unit 3 faculty, including both full-

time and part-time faculty (lecturers), who have taught at least one course during the

current or previous academic year; and be it further

Resolved: That the Constitution Committee draft the appropriate language to revise the relevant

sections of the Constitution and Bylaws to reflect this change; and be it finally

Resolved: That the revised Constitution and Bylaws be presented to the Academic Senate for

approval and subsequently to the full faculty electorate for ratification in accordance

with the procedures outlined in the existing governance documents.
