Roster Management

Fraternity and Sorority Life (FSL) manages chapter rosters using Google Tables. Google Tables is an online tool created by Google to support data management. Each organization is given access to its respective table, where the Chapter President is tasked with updating membership each semester.

FSL collects the student's name, CWID, campus student email, new member date, and status (alumni/ active/ inactive/ disaffiliated/ potential new member). This management provides us the opportunity to update the community with membership totals, semester grade point averages, mandated training completions, and be in compliance with Assembly Bill AB524.

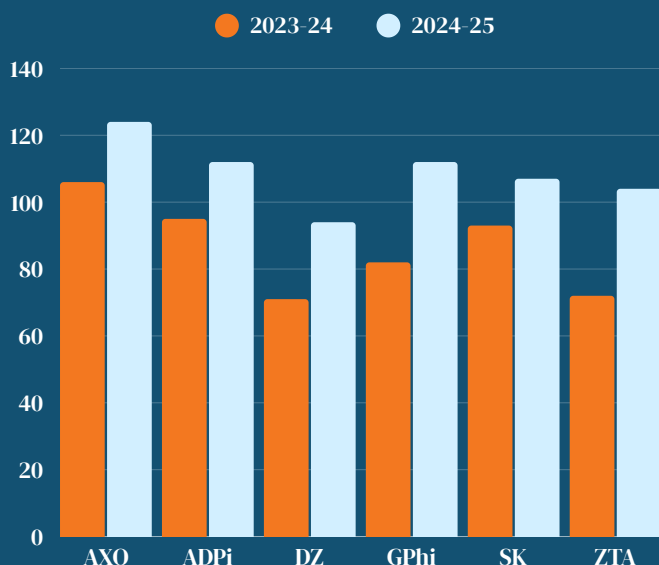
FSL Membership

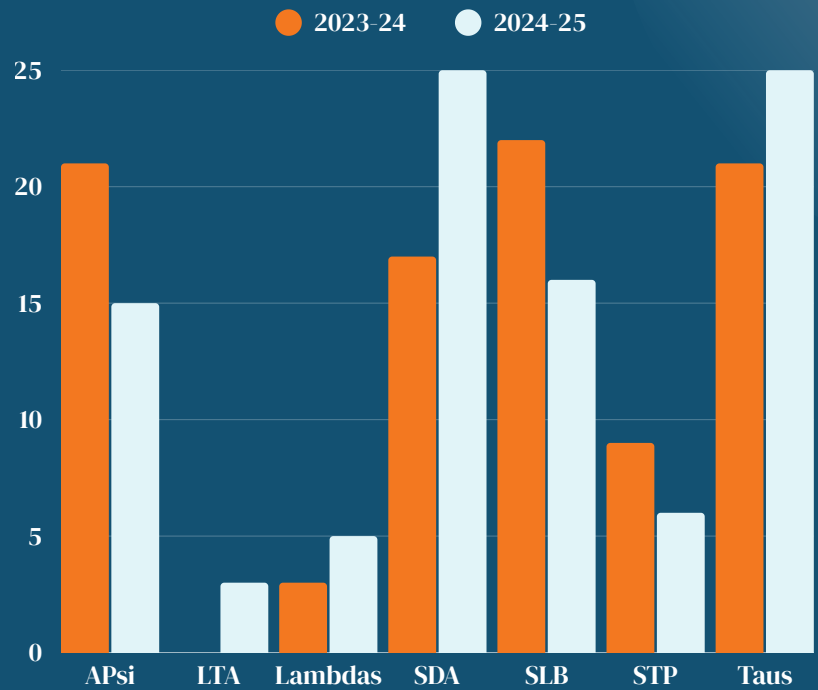

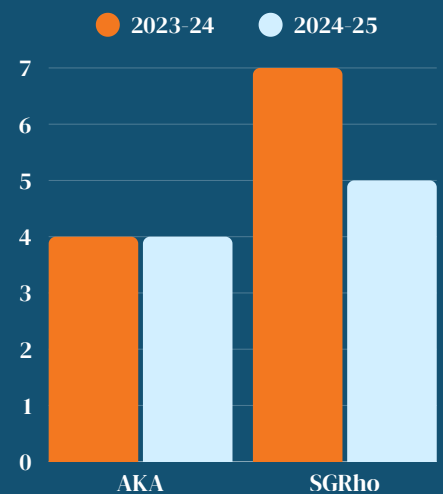

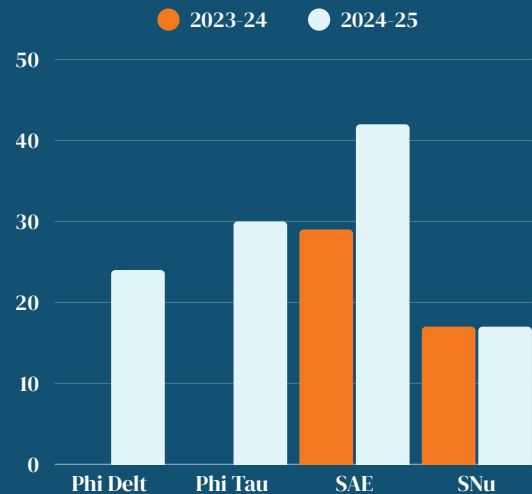
Interfraternity Council:

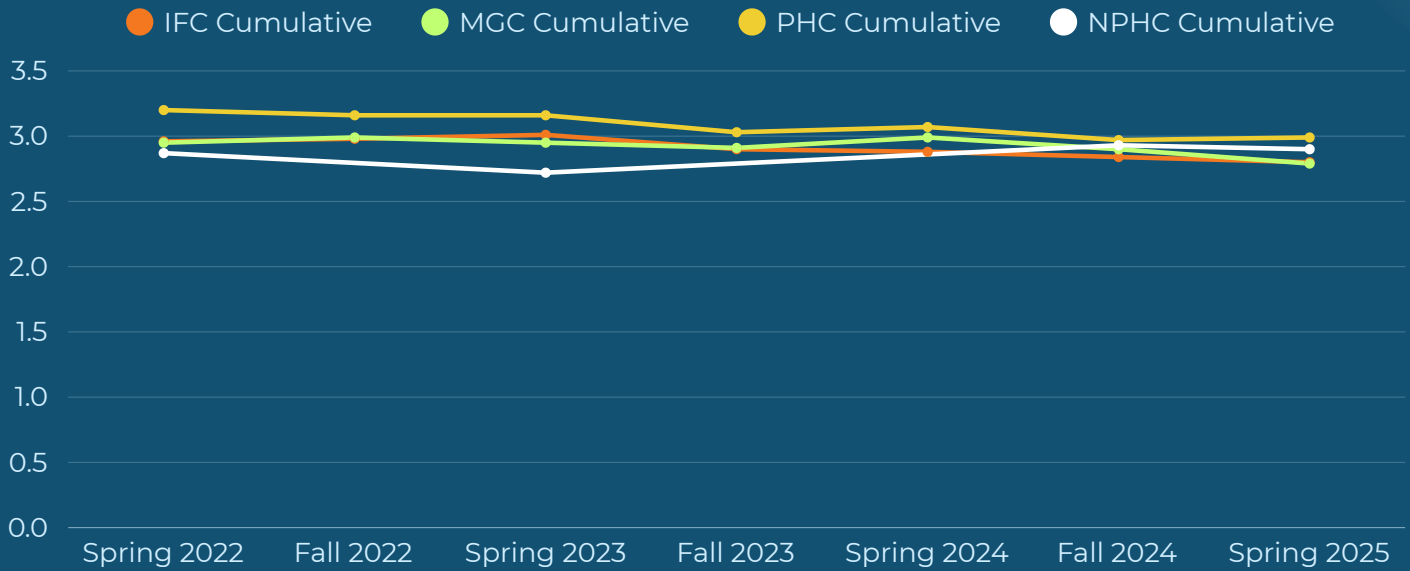

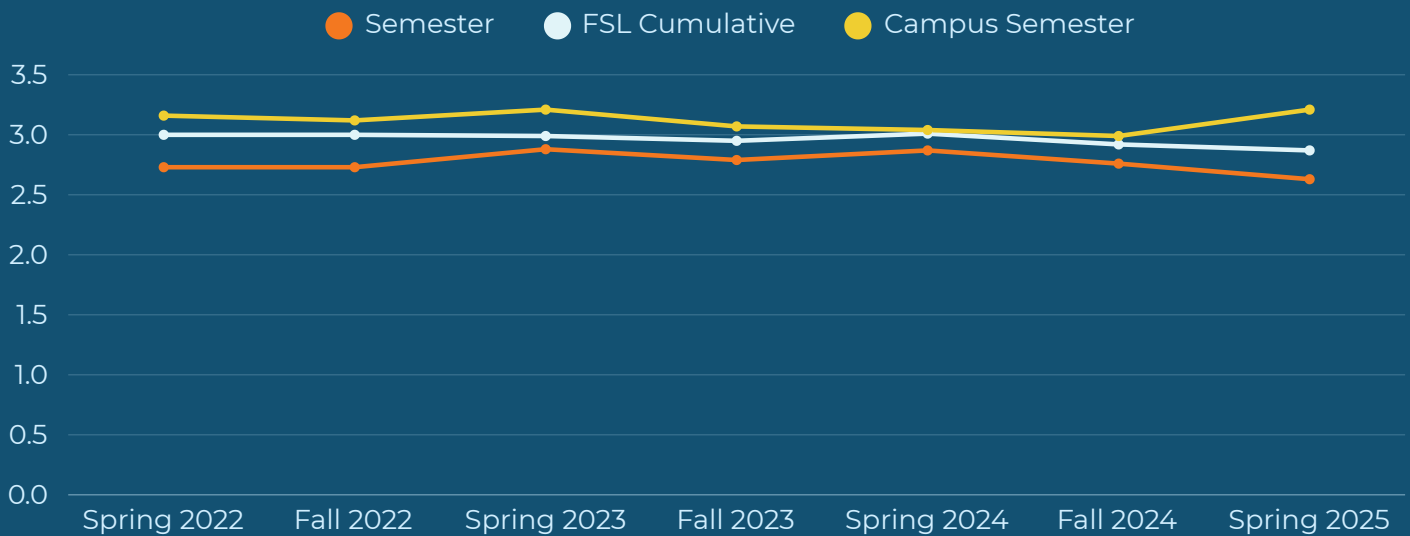
Grade Report Trend

Chapter Education & Safety

"Becoming a Member" (BAM) is a new member orientation training hosted during fall and spring semesters. It's designed for students who are participating in the new member process for an FSL chapter.

Alcohol & Other Drugs Training:

Using a harm-reduction approach to alcohol use, the "Titan Up the Party" presentation by the TitanWell department addresses the basics of alcohol consumptions. The presentation includes information on standard drink size, blood alcohol concentration (BAC), binge drinking behaviors, the Good Samaritan law, and how to recognize the signs of alcohol poisoning.

Title IX Training:

In partnering with the Civil Rights and Equity department, students learn about their rights and responsibilities such as affirmative consent, campus reporting options, and campus resources.

Well-Being Training:

Counseling and Psychological Services (CAPS) presents a training focused on mental health and well-being. Topics discussed include anxiety, addictions and how to identify them, and CAPS services available to students.

Hazing Prevention Training:

Hazing Prevention provides members with an opportunity to learn how hazing can be exhibited, different types of hazing, and also uses case studies to provide realistic scenarios of hazing cases that have occurred. Students are asked to identify types and levels of hazing, ways to intervene, and campus reporting options. CSU policies and California hazing laws are also covered in this workshop.

Education & Safety Assessment

Fraternity and Sorority Life provides BAM trainings each semester. Within an academic year we have successfully provided training to our organizations at Cal State Fullerton.

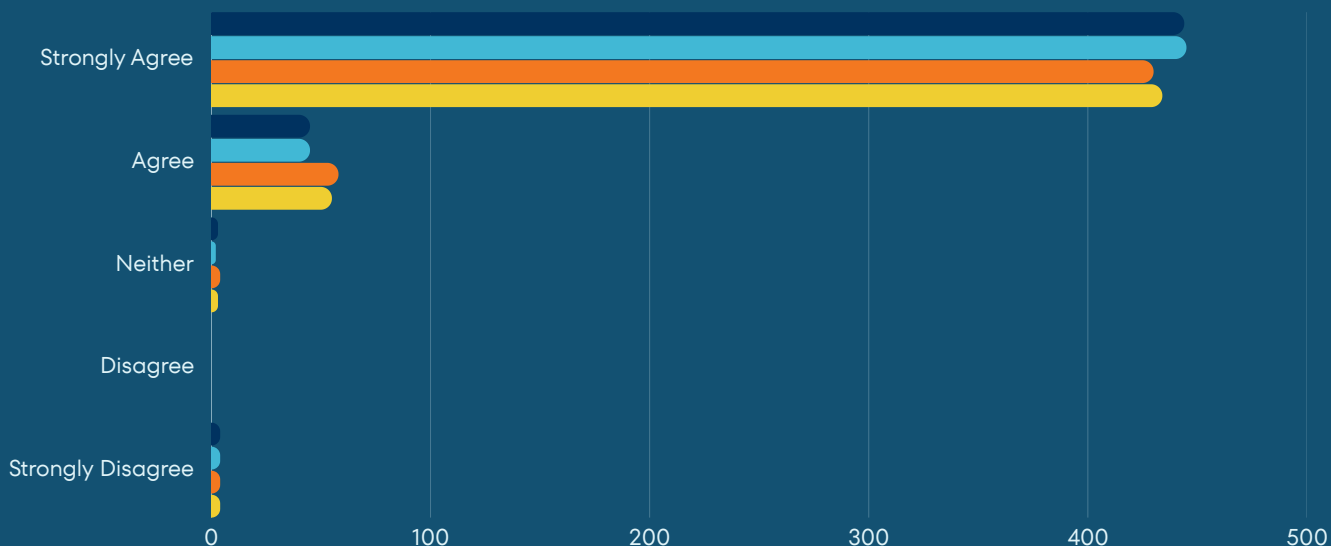

Assessment through Learning Competencies:

Our BAM assessment is created using student leadership learning competencies that focuses on personal behavior, learning and reasoning, and interpersonal interactions. After a student completes a BAM session they complete an evaluation. The four statements below are the responses received from 496 students.

Giving Back to the City of Fullerton

This academic year, the FSL council's hosted several philanthropic events for the community. The recipients of these items and monetary donation include the City of Fullerton and our Cal State Fullerton campus partners.



Love Fullerton 2025:

Love Fullerton is a community service-based event hosted by the city of Fullerton. On April 26, 2025, the city of Fullerton was able to mulch the streets. Mulching is important because it preserves water and prevents weed from growing.

MGC Fall Fest:

During the month of October the MGC community hosted a three day philanthropy event. Day 1 and 2 consisted of coin wars on Titanwalk during the day. On Day 1, in the evening, MGC had a game night and Day 2's evening was bowling and billiards. For the 3rd day, the community made hygiene bags to donate to a local shelter.

MGC Green Day:

The MGC organizations partnered with the Fullerton Arboretum to hoe the grass and educate the community on the care that it takes to keep the arboretum running for all to enjoy.

Panhellenic Dunk Tank:

For their annual dunk tank Panhellenic hosted their event during Greek Week and donated their contributions to the ASI Children's Center. All Panhellenic Presidents participated this year to be dunked by the community.



Greek Week 2025 Philanthropy:

Children's Center Donations:

The CSUF Children's Center supports student parents by providing affordable, quality childcare - making higher education more accessible for families. From diapers to daily care, their impact is felt campus-wide.

As CSUF FSL's Philanthropy we raised a record breaking amount of \$72,550 for the Children's Center.

We had an attendance of 295 people from our community and sat in the right field MVP sections at the stadium!



AFLV West Conference

AFLV (Association of Fraternal Leadership & Values) exists to accelerate progress in fraternity/sorority communities through change-enabling experiences. AFLV West is also the oldest regional fraternal conference that has met regularly since its establishment in 1948.

Each year, more than 800 participants from more than 50 campuses come together for an experience with programming at all levels of the fraternity/sorority experience.

Attendees:

In the 2024-2025 academic year, we took 20 council members from Panhellenic Council, Interfraternity Council, Multicultural Greek Council, and National Pan-Hellenic Council.

Recruitment/ Intake Opportunities

Panhellenic Primary Recruitment:

Panhellenic Council's Recruitment Committee hosted a four-day recruitment for interests looking to join a Panhellenic sorority. Below you can find the RFM (Release Figure Methodology) report from their 2024 Primary Recruitment.

IFC Recruitment:

In the Fall semester IFC had 89 students interested in going through their recruitment process. By the end of Spring 2025 we had the community grow by 37 members from the previous year.

MGC Recruitment:

Our MGC organization's recruitment efforts start at Discoverfest and continue through the month. With an increased interest from students, our MGC membership has shown a growth trend from the previous academic year!

NPHC Intake:

In the Fall semester, AKA and SGRho went through intake and had 5 new members enter the NPHC community.



Discoverfest:

The Office of Student Life & Leadership and Associated Students, Inc., co-sponsors Discoverfest at the start of every Fall and Spring Semester. This 2-day event is CSUF's largest involvement event for registered student organizations to showcase the student life activity at CSUF. Attendees will learn about engagement opportunities on campus and how to join these registered orgs.

Experience CSUF:

Student Life & Leadership met with admitted Titans on April 24, 2025 to share with them the multitude of opportunities we offer. In addition to our SLL and FSL professional staff, we had Panhellenic & MGC Executive members share their personal experience in being part of the FSL community!

FSL Honors Awards & Banquet 2025

AB 524 : Campus Recognized Fraternity and Sorority Transparency Act

AB 524 requires that campus-recognized fraternities and sororities provide the following information to the campus on an annual basis by July 1:

- Total chapter membership
- Total new member class
- Chapter fundraisers
- Chapter events
- Chapter philanthropies
- Community service involvement
- Sanctioned chapter events
- Chapter conduct

The bill requires that the campus compile and maintain the collected information into a publicly accessible report which is posted and archived, on appropriate webpages and also released to the campus.

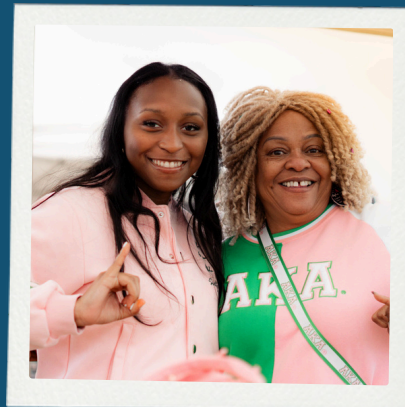
