

Required documents:

Submit the following documents to **VETERANS@FULLERTON.EDU** CalVet Fee Waiver award letter containing a 16 digit code will be received via email by VSO

Plan A:

You may be eligible if you're:

1. A Child (Unmarried)

- Your parent is a veteran who is 100% disabled due to service,
- Died from a service-connected cause.
- Must be 14 to 27 years old (or up to 30 if you're also a veteran).
- The disability or death must have occurred before your 21st birthday.
- 2. A Spouse or Registered Domestic Partner (RDP)
- Your spouse is a wartime veteran rated as totally disabled due to service, or
- You are the unmarried surviving spouse or RDP of a wartime veteran who died from a service-connected cause.
- No age limits.

3. A Dependent

• Your veteran parent is missing in action, captured, or detained by a foreign power.

Other Rules:

- The veteran must have served at least one day during wartime or received a campaign/expeditionary medal.
- No income limits apply.
- You cannot get both Plan A and VA Chapter 35 benefits at the same time—you must choose one.

Plan B:

A child may qualify if their parent is a veteran who:

- Has a service-connected disability,
- Had one at the time of death, or
- Died from service-related causes.

Requirements:

- The child's total income (including parental support) must be below a set limit.
- Income is based on the previous year's earnings. [If no income, applicant must submit a "Verification of Non-filing" letter from the IRS with application.]
- No wartime service or age limits are required.

CHILDREN ARE THE ONLY DEPENDENTS ELIGIBLE **UNDER THIS PLAN**

CAN BE COMBINED WITH VA CH. 35 BENEFIT

Plan C:

- 1. Dependents of California National Guard members are eligible if the member:
- Was killed while on active state duty,
- Died from a service-related disability, or
- Is permanently disabled due to state service.
- 2. Surviving spouses or registered domestic partners (RDPs) who have not remarried are also eligible.

Important:

"Active service to the state" means the Guard member was activated under Section 146 of the Military and Veterans Code (not Section 143). You must provide a copy of those specific orders to prove eligibility.

Plan D:

- Medal of Honor recipients and their children under age 27 may be eligible.
- Only for undergraduate studies.
- There are income and age limits.
- You can receive VA Chapter 35 benefits at the same time.

CalVet Fee Waiver applications must be submitted to your local Veteran Service Office (VSO) or by logging into the Cal Vet website.

General list of application documents (varies per applicant):

- 1. Application
- 2. The veteran's DD-214
- 3. Applicant's birth certificate
- 4. Service-connected disability statement (one you sent us)
- 5. 'Non-filing' letter from IRS (if applicable)

CalVet Fee Waiver does not pay campus based fees and any other associated fees outside tuition. Student is responsible for any fees outside tuition.

IMPORTANT:

- Undergrad: CalVet Fee Waiver only covers Fall/Spring semesters
- Grad: CalVet Fee Waiver only covers Fall/Spring semesters

Note: Certain programs available only for graduate students may include coverage for summer semesters. ** Contact us to verify **

- CalVet Fee Waiver only covers 'state' supported programs.
- Student must reapply every academic year.
